You will need:

- 24 small envelopes

- String



- ➤ On the 24 cards write down ways in which you can get ready for Jesus.
- Number and decorate 24 envelopes.
- ➤ Put the cards in the envelopes and add a few sweeties for special days like Sundays
- ➤ Hang up your sealed envelopes on some string and start getting ready for Jesus!

A suggestion for your family:

Wrap an empty box up as a special present. Every day of Advent, offer what you have done to Jesus by putting the card in the present box. On Christmas day, you have a present of wonderful things you have given to Jesus.
