Great Things from Small Beginnings

Here's a few activities you can do to illustrate the idea that great things can come from small beginnings.

Rubber Band Ball

Fold a thick rubber band in half 2

or 3 times. Then wrap another medium sized



rubber band round this folded one, as many times as you can. Continue wrapping bands until you have a ball. For more detailed instructions have a look here.

Food Colouring

Count how many teaspoons of water it takes to fill a cup. Then add a quarter of a teaspoon of food colouring and look how quickly the water changes colour.



Make bread

Whilst making bread, notice how small the amount of dried yeast is that you put in. Notice also how small the dough is before you prove it. Then how much it has grown once it has been proved.
