CORPUS CHRISTI

....The Eucharist is the high point of our lives. It is thanksgiving - The Thanksgiving. It is the Sacrifice of Calvary, the once-and-for-all sacrifice through which our Saviour saved us from sin – made present every time the Mass is celebrated. It is the Lord's gift of Himself, first given at the Last Supper when He commanded us to 'do this in memory of me.' The Blessed Sacrament, then, is the Real Presence. Like the disciples at Emmaus, we 'recognise Him in the breaking of bread' – the bread that is become the Body of Christ, the Wine that is become the Blood of Christ. As we receive Him, we are at one with Him and because we are at one with Him, we are one with each other. This is the reality we celebrate on this great feast.

It is from this celebration that we are sent forth to bring to the world around us the message that the Lord has died and is risen, the message that is the Good News for the world. The Eucharist is, therefore, the fount of our mission as Christ's people. The Lord gives us Himself that we might bring Him to others.

May this Corpus Christi celebration – at our Cathedral and in our parishes – bring us to focus once more on all the Lord has done for us, on his giving of Himself to us in this wonderful sacrament and on the mission that flows from our union with Him.

PRAYER & LITURGY

FIRST HOLY COMMUNIONS_

Please keep in your prayers the Children who will be making their First Holy Communions this Saturday at St. Joseph's Church. (Please note that the 10am Mass will be very full – and there won't be the possibility of Confessions afterwards as there is a FHC Liturgy at 12 noon and a 2nd Mass at 1pm.) Over the coming weeks the First Communion Masses will be celebrated in each of the Communities – we offer our prayerful support and encouragement to them all.

SOLEMINITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI

During the Masses this Sunday there will be three additional elements: After the (brief!) Homily we will have the Renewal of the Extraordinary Ministers of Communion. We are grateful to them for their taking Holy Communion to the Sick and Housebound and enabling this distribution of Communion at Mass and assure them of our prayers.

Given the Bishop's recent permission to offer the Chalice at Communion this Corpus Christi is an appropriate Sunday on which to make the Precious Blood available. It will, of course, be each individual's choice whether they receive from the chalice or not. The Church teaches that the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ is present in both the Sacred Host and Precious Blood.

The third way in which we mark this Corpus Christi will be with a short procession at the end of Mass. A time of Adoration will be followed by a simple Benediction. (This will replace the Notices and the ordinary blessing.)
