A WEEK OF NOVENA TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

This week we find ourselves already in the midst of the "Novena to the Holy Spirit": the commemoration of the nine days of intense prayer held by Mary, the Apostles and the women in the Upper Room, from the day of Ascension, until the Holy Spirit descended on them at Pentecost. These days form a fitting end to our Month of Prayer for Vocations, and we are inviting you to a "final push" on not one, not two but three occasions this week!

- 3. **Saturday 10am 12 noon St Joseph's**: Adoration and Prayer for Priests, led by Deacon Sean, in place of the usual morning Mass and Confessions (The priests will be concelebrating Mass at Allen Hall Seminary as Scott formally becomes a Candidate for the Priesthood.)
