



MONTH OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS - GET INVOLVED IN GUILDFORD

This May, please pray every day for more priests, as part of the Diocesan Month of Prayer for Vocations. Thursday, because it is the day of the Lord's Supper, is traditionally a special day for this, so here in Guildford, we thought we would use each **Thursday Evening Prayer online** during the month as a chance for us all as a parish to come together and ask the Lord to send us workers in his vineyard. Imagine if every individual could come together united in prayer! Whether you have tuned in before or not, why not join us **online at 6pm**?

We will also use our **10.30am Holy Hour** at St Joseph's each Saturday of the month to pray for this intention. Many parishioners are also using the **Rosary** too (after all: no better prayer during May!) Our Lady, Queen of Priests, pray for us!

Any priest that you ask will tell you that he had the experience of being

prayed for and encouraged by faithful people - friends and strangers alike - when he was discerning his vocation. Pope Francis has spoken about his own experience doing this:

'If we are indeed convinced that the Holy Spirit continues to inspire vocations to the priesthood and the religious life, we can "once more cast out the nets" in the Lord's name, with complete confidence. We can dare, as we should, to tell each young person to ask whether this is the path that they are meant to follow.

Occasionally, I would bring this up with young people, and they would respond almost jokingly: "No, that's not for me!" Yet, a few years later, some of them were in the seminary. The Lord cannot fail in his promise to provide the Church with shepherds, for without them she would not be able to live and carry out her mission. If it is true that some priests do not give good witness, that does not mean that the Lord stops calling. On the contrary, he doubles the stakes, for he never ceases to care for his beloved Church.'

DATES AHEAD

Currently over 70 parishioners are involved in **Belong and Believe** - and there is room for more. On May 20th - there will be a **Day of Retreat** for Participants at St. Edward's.

From April 30th until Pentecost Sunday the parish is invited to join in **Praying for Vocations**.

At the beginning of May we celebrate the **Coronation of their Majesties** with a screening of the Coronation (May 6th - St. Mary's) and a Parish Mass and Picnic (St. Edward's - May 7th).

On Sunday May 14th there will be the **Marian Procession** at St. Mary's (3pm).

On May 20th in St. Joseph's and May 23rd in St. Pius there will be the **Annual Time of Reflection** for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.

On Friday 26th May we are invited to join, in person at St. Joseph's or via Livestream, in a **Vigil of Prayer for Scott** who will be received as a Candidate for Ordination the next day in Allen Hall Seminary.

On the Sunday at St. Mary's we will celebrate **Pentecost** at the 11.15am Mass on May 28th with the Belong and Believe participants coming together and an opportunity to celebrate with Scott at a shared lunch afterwards.

During June each of the communities will celebrate their own **First Communion Masses** locally - and on Sunday June 11th all are invited to take part in the **Corpus Christi Procession** around St. Edwards (3pm).

In July our Confirmation Candidates will journey to Arundel Cathedral (which is celebrating its 150th Anniversary) to be **Confirmed by Bishop Richard**.

The Summer brings the **Lourdes Pilgrimage** and (well earned) Summer Holidays!

A&B LOURDES PILGRIMAGE

LOURDES PILGRIMAGE

Applications from pilgrims requiring assistance to journey with the Diocese Pilgrimage to Lourdes this summer are back to pre-Covid numbers – which is wonderful news, but it does mean we now need lots of helpers, nurses and HCA's to apply to make sure we have enough people to care for them in Lourdes.

"Being a helper is an act of service that many of us do not get to offer during our day to day lives. Giving our time and care for a week in Lourdes can make such a positive impact on the life and wellbeing of the people we help, and ourselves. There are many ways that you can help someone, the first step is to apply!".

The diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes takes place 28 July to 3 August for those travelling by air, or 27 July to 4 August for those travelling by coach or jumbulance. The cost for Helpers and Clinicians is £680 (subsidised) or £850 full price. There are further subsidies which may be available.
