## Talk about

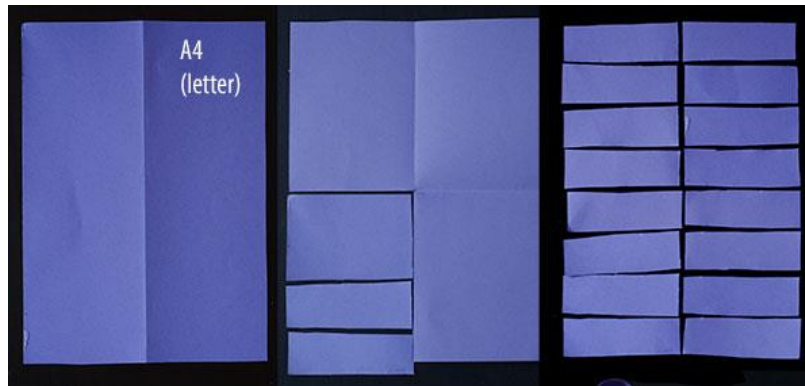
What can you offer back to God, from all the gifts he has given you? Here are some examples to get you thinking:

## Create a bunch of grapes

- 1) Cut out a template of a bunch of grapes. You can use the one on the next page or draw your own
- 2) Cut out small rectangles from a green or purple A4 sheet



3) Write onto the rectangles some things you can offer to God

4) Curl the rectangles

5) Stick the rectangles onto the template, thinking about how you are offering these things to God
